1. Welcome back to Church, we are pleased to announce that we are reopened! In line with government restrictions, the following rules will apply until such time the government changes its regulations:
 - CACV will open its doors to the vaccinated and unvaccinated. The vaccination status of attendees will not be checked.
 - CACV staff and volunteers, however, will be required to be double vaccinated and must show evidence of vaccination to administration staff to serve unless you have a valid medical exemption. We understand that this may impact people please do let us know and speak to your pastors.
 - There is now a venue cap of a maximum of 50 people not including volunteers. The Chief Usher will now be ensuring that this policy is maintained.
 - To ensure the continued health and safety of our members, masks must be worn indoors at all times unless eating/drinking or speaking on stage. Temperature checks will still be required at the door.

We look forward to having everyone back indoors in an orderly and safe way! If you have any queries or concerns with the policy please speak to the pastors or any of the Combined Board members.
2. The Food Ministry, would like to thank all brothers and sisters who have faithfully given to the ministry. We wanted to provide an update to the Church that in the last year the Food Ministry has been on hold due to covid restrictions and for health and safety reasons. We anticipate that it will continue to be on hold until sometime next year and we will update brother and sisters when we plan to do so.
